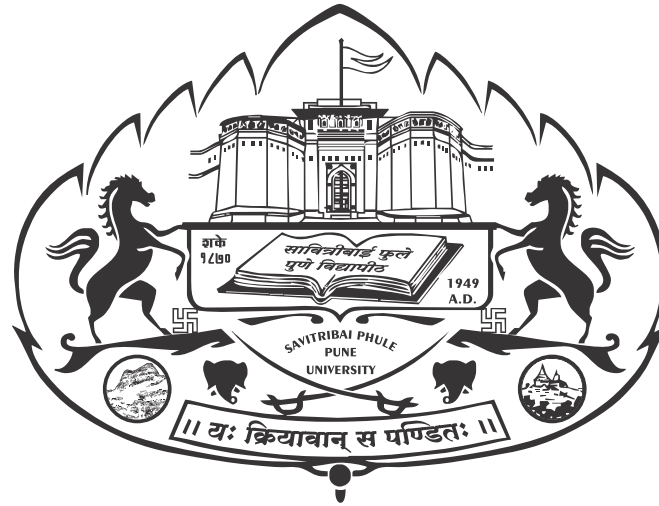

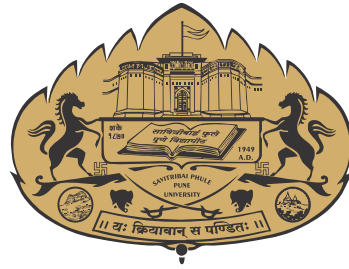

It gives me a great pleasure to write forward to the 67th Annual Report of the Savitribai Phule Pune University, SPPU is one of the largest university in the country in terms of affiliated colleges and students enrolment.

MHRD's National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) has ranked SPPU at 10th position amongst Indian universities and at a bright 18th position in the overall ranking of all the higher education Institutions in India. It is also known as one of the most prestigious universities in the world. SPPU is ranked a place of distinction along with other seven Indian universities at the UK based Times Higher Education World Ranking 2016-17, where it has been placed between 601 and 800 among Universities worldwide.

Another significant achievement of our University is re-accreditation by NAAC in March 2017 at A+ Grade with a CGPA of 3.60. As a part of our mission, we have collaborated with reputed global institutions and universities to form a centre of excellence in the teaching, research & extension. Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) have been signed with various international universities from Asia, Europe, Australia and USA. SPPU has signed the MoU with WuFang University, Taiwan to start new courses on Disaster Management & National Security. Recently, SPPU has become a beneficiary of one of the biggest social science & humanities research project entitled "Culture Heritage & Identities of Europe's Future (CHIEF)" funded by the European commission.

SPPU has received significant amount of funding from MHRD for various projects such as "Faculty Development Centre" under Academic Staff College, "Teaching Learning Centre" under Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya National Mission on Teacher and Training and for Global Initiative of Academic Network (GIAN). University Grants Commission has also provided significant amount of funds for various projects including second phase of UPE. With the help of these funds the university has achieved excellent success in academic and research activities which is visible through high quality publications in international journals.

For all round development of students, they are encouraged to participate in various activities organized at State and National level such as "Avishkar" a state level competition & other sports competitions. The students have bagged large number of Awards and Prizes including Gold & Silver medals in these competitions.

Beside the academic activities the university has contributed significantly and achieved grand success in various outreach socially oriented programmes which cater to the needs of senior citizens, women, farmers and unorganized workers.

I am very much pleased to write a message on the occasion of publication of 67th Annual Report of our University.

Savitribai Phule Pune University is the prestigious University in our country having student strength of over six Lakhs. The University has 49 Academic Departments under various academic streams. These academic departments run 271 academic programs. The University has 650 Affiliated Colleges, 211 Recognized Management Institutions, 73 Research Institutes and 20 other Recognized Research Institutes of national repute. The University has created facilities such as a Skill Development Center, Placement Center, Digital Classroom, Alumni Association, etc., in an effort to enhance the quality of education and well-being of the students. There are 9 Autonomous Colleges and 10 Colleges are recognized by UGC as College with Potential for Excellence and 1 College as College with Excellence. The University and 9 Affiliated Colleges have received funds from UGC for introduction of B.Voc. Courses. 10 Affiliated Colleges have also received grant under Community College Scheme.

Savitribai Phule Pune University is a most preferred destination for international students. Presently, students from 75 countries are engaged in various academic programs in the University.

The University has implemented several online modules in admission process, student support and examination related process. The University has received E-Governance Award, 2013 from Government of Maharashtra in the category of IT for Environment. The University has also received Solar Thermal Award, 2013 for the wonderful contribution made by the School of Energy Studies in the field of Solar Water Heating System. Our University is ranked as best in teaching (only next to IISc, Bangalore) amongst Indian Universities by the Times Higher Education World University Rankings in 2016. In order to improve the academic standard on the campus as well as in the affiliated colleges and recognized institutes, the University has successfully implemented Quality Improvement Program. The University also provides financial assistance to the Colleges to implement Earn and Learn scheme for needy and economically weaker students. The University has successfully nurtured a research culture on the campus and its affiliated colleges. The University organizes Research Project competition in all the three districts. The selected projects are presented in the AVISHKAR-a State Level Research Competition. The University has glorious track record of being recipient of General Championship for 8 times in last 12 years.

The University has collaborations with 27 national reputed organizations and 30 international universities and organizations. It has actively involved in the ERASMUS MUNDUS Program. The University is recipient of the OBAMA SINGH 21st Century Knowledge Initiative Award in 2013 under the Indo-Norwegian Co-operation Program. The Department of Health Sciences, Bioinformatics and Environmental Science have faculty and students exchange program with Telemark University, Norway. There are collaborations with Penn State University, University of Massachusetts, Tubingen University (Germany), Monash University, Australia. They provide exposure to the laboratories, work culture and infrastructure to the faculty members. The University has signed MOU with University of South Africa for joint research collaboration.

All these endeavours are greatly helping in the quest of making possible, access, equity and excellence in higher education. I believe that the teaching and non-teaching staff and students are real contributors in these praiseworthy achievements.

1. UNIVERSITY : FABRIC AND FEATURES

Maharashtra and especially the Savitribai Phule Pune University (Formerly, University of Pune) have always been at the forefront of evolving new paradigms, which involve new thought processes. Savitribai Phule Pune University, one of the premier universities in India, is located in the North-Western part of Pune city in a picture sake lush green surrounding sprawling over 411 acres. The University is symbolically identified with the Main Building, it is a monumental building with a beautiful architecture, was once the summer residence of the Governor of Bombay in the days of the British Raj. Built in 1864 architecturally, it defies classification through its spiritual antecedents and the 80 feet flag tower has been described as a 'Victorian rendering of an Italian campanile'.

The University is one of the largest and prestigious Universities in the world with students' strength of over 6 lakh. The university houses 49 academic departments under 11 academic streams and each of which has its own separate buildings running 271 academic programs. The University is having 650 affiliated colleges, 211 recognized management institutions, 73 research institutes and 20 other recognized research institutes of National repute. There are 9 Autonomous colleges and 10 colleges are recognized by UGC as "Colleges with Potential for Excellence (CPE)" and 1 college as College with Excellence. The university campus and affiliated 9 colleges have received grants from UGC for introduction of B.Voc Courses and 10 colleges have received grants under Community College schemes. The university and Abasaheb Garware College are also a part of DDKAUSHAL Programme of the MHRD. The University has on campus in house capacity to provide accommodation to - 3000 male and female students with separate residential facility for international students, teachers and staff. The University runs a chain of refectory, hostel mess and canteens on the campus. The Central Jayakar Library is one of the best centers of reference and information in the country. The library subscribes to Indian and foreign research journals, and also receives periodicals on gratis and exchange basis. It has more than 5,21,747 books and Journals on varied subjects. Inter-library loan facility is extended to many colleges, institutions and government agencies. The Jayakar Library has preserved a wealth of ancient Indian texts in the form of manuscripts and books.

The University is a symbol of international integration as the number of foreign students studying in this university is largest in the country i.e. about 859 students from 75 countries.

The University has created new facilities such as the Centre for Skill Development, the Placement Centre, the Digital Classroom and the Alumni Association for the enhancement of educational standard and the welfare of the students.

MAIN FEATURES

1. Introduction of Innovative Programs:

The five year integrated course in Bioinformatics and Biotechnology, blending of science and engineering under Technology Faculty such as Integrated M. Tech. Ph. D. Programme, M.Tech. (Aviation), M.Sc. Industrial Mathematics with Computer Applications, Modeling & Simulation, MBA in Pharmaceuticals & Bio-technology, Health Sciences, Medicinal Chemistry, Atmospheric & Space Sciences, Environmental Sciences, Integrated BSc-BEd, BSc Blended are some of the innovative curricula offered at the university apart from the traditional core competences course. With the establishment of 'Design Innovation Center' and a dedicated '**Skill** development Center,' the education at the university is transforming students from being job seekers to become job providers.

2. Research and Learning Infrastructure:

The Center for Modeling and Simulation, has installed SAHASTRAR High Performance computing cluster that comprises of 46 computer nodes, 2 GPU nodes, and 400 TB PFS storage. The Data Center (DC) facility of tier II type has been installed to cater SAHASTRAR HPC cluster. DC is equipped with Fire Alarm system, fire suppression system, VESDA, CCTV surveillance, Rodent Repellent system, water leak detection system, and Building Management System. The Central Instrumentation Facility (CIF) has been established at Savitribai Phule Pune University. The University has invested more than Rs. 20 Crore for the establishment of this facility. Most of the sophisticated equipment like Nuclear Magnetic Resonance (NMR) 500 MHz, Liquid Chromatography and Mass Spectroscopy (LC-MS-MS) with TOF, Gas Chromatography and Mass Spectroscopy (GC-MS-MS), Field Emission Scanning Electron Microscope (FE SEM), Confocal Microscope, Single Crystal X-Ray diffractometer, Circular Dichroism - polarimeter, BET-Surface Area Analyzer have been procured and are in operation. The University has plans to replicate similar facility at Ahmednagar and Nashik Sub-Centres. Many universities, academic institutes, national research institutes, defense institutes, and industries in India are benefited from this facility. The School of Energy Studies has established a National facility for Solar-Thermal testing. Digital Weather monitoring stations are established at the Department of Environmental Science and at the site of Solar-Thermal testing facility. A language laboratory has been established on the campus.

3. Automation and e-governance

The University has successfully implemented several online modules for example Online Eligibility, Online Migration, Online Quality Improvement Programme applications, Online Travel Grant applications, Online Scholarship applications, Online Affiliation & activities of Students Facilitation Centre, Online PG admissions. University has successfully conducted Online Ph.D. Entrance Examination paper-I at 58 centers in Pune, Nashik &

Ahmednagar districts and abroad also. In examination section also several processes have been made online. Various certifications requests, application for photo copy, revaluation, transcripts, degree certificate, delivery of question papers at examination centres, etc. are made online.

4. Awards Received by University:

Savitribai Phule Pune University has undertaken two prestigious projects, the first one was Pune University Network, for which the University has received 'e-Governance Awards 2013' from Govt. of Maharashtra in the form of silver medal in the category of IT for Environment. The second one is Regional Test Centre for Solar Water Heating System at School of Energy Studies which received "Solar Thermal Award 2013" from Ministry of New and Renewable Energy, New Delhi. The university has been ranked as best in teaching (only next to IISC, Bangalore) amongst Indian universities by the Times Higher Education World University Rankings in 2016.

5. Introduction of Quality Improvement Programme:

To improve the academic standard and the quality of education on the campus as well as in the affiliated colleges and recognized institutes the Savitribai Phule Pune University has introduced the Quality Improvement Programme (QIP) Scheme. Under this initiative, the University organizes Seminars/Conferences/Workshops at National/International level for students and faculty as well as provides grants to affiliated colleges & recognized institutes for the construction of Parking Stand, Students' Facility Centers, Guest House, Ladies and Gents washrooms and also for construction of ramps for physically challenged persons. The University also provides financial support for the purchase of equipments for office, laboratory, and sports, under the QIP scheme. The University has now introduced a new concept of "Cluster Colleges" and provides financial support for various activities under this scheme in which the Seminars / Conferences / Workshops are organized for students, teachers, principals and administrative staff, and management persons of the colleges and also for society. The University also provides financial assistance to the colleges, catering to the needs of tribal students and 'Earn While You Learn Scheme' for needy and economically weaker students.

6. Promotion of Research:

Savitribai Phule Pune University has nurtured a research culture on the campus and in its affiliated colleges. The Director BCUD, OSDs and his office take special efforts to help affiliated colleges, recognized institutions and the university departments and provide grants under various state-level, national and international funding schemes of apex bodies of the government, RUSA and foreign universities as well as from university funds. To maintain high quality research output, the University organizes 'Research Project Competition' at different places in all the three districts under the university jurisdiction. A large number of students participate in these competitions. The selected projects/papers

are presented in the 'Avishkar'- A State Level Research Competition' held annually in different Universities. The university has excellent track record in 'Avishkar' research competition and has received General Championship for eight times out of ten at State level. The university provides seed research funding under 'BCUD Research Project Scheme' from its own funds, to the teachers on campus and in affiliated colleges to explore research ideas leading to larger proposals for generating funding from various agencies. The university has made a budgetary provision of Rs. 9 Crore every year for this initiative.

The colleges affiliated to the university are also doing very good research and receive sizable grants for major and minor research projects from various funding agencies in addition to the grants provided by the University. During the last five years, affiliated colleges have also received funds from DST under FIST and are also recognized by DBT under "Star College" scheme. Affiliated colleges also take interest in filing patents, and so far, 125 patents have been filed by affiliated colleges.

7. New International Collaborations:

The University has collaborations with 27 National reputed organizations and 30 International Universities/Organizations. The University is actively involved in the Erasmus Mundus Programme and has recently got approval for the partnership with EXPERTS4 Asia (coordinated by Gottingen University, Germany), EUPHRATES-EU Promoting Health through Research, Applied technology, Education and Science in India (co-ordinated by University of Santiago de Compostable, Spain), EMINTE, (co-ordinated by Lund University, Sweden), India4EU (co-ordinated by Politecnico di Torino, Italy).

The University is the 2013 grant recipient of the Obama-Singh 21st Century Knowledge Initiative Award, now known as Indo-US 21st Century Knowledge Initiative Award and has undertaken a joint research project, 'Inclusive Universities: linking diversity, equity and excellence for the 21st Century" with the University of Massachusetts, Amherst, USA.

Under the Indo-Norwegian Co-operation programme, the Department of Health Sciences, Bioinformatics and Environmental Sciences have a faculty and student exchange programme with Telemark University, Norway. The research collaborations with prestigious foreign universities that include Penn State University, University of Massachusetts, Amherst (U-MASS), Gottingen, Tubingen University (Germany), Telemark University Norway. Monash University Australia, provide the faculty members involved, exposure to the laboratories, the work culture and infrastructure. The University has recently signed MOU with University of South Africa (UNISA) for joint research collaboration and teacher/student exchange program. There are a large number of International Guests and delegations who visit the University and the International Centre of the University. Some of them are as follows:

8. Establishment of Skill Development Centre (SDC):

Skill Development Centre at Savitribai Phule Pune University is established in March 2014 with an objective to eliminate disconnect between academics and the reality in the global job market. The Centre has introduced three year B.Voc. Degree Programs, which are well focused on training undergraduate and post graduate students of University in various employable skills so as to enhance their employability. Rigorous training is given to students in communication skills, sound values and professional ethics to enable them to venture out with confidence and prove their caliber in the competitive workplace.

Nine colleges affiliated to SPPU have also been identified by UGC to introduce B.Voc. Programs from the academic year 2014-15. Each college has received a grant of Rs. 1.85 Crore for the introduction of these courses. Apart from these, 10 colleges have received grants under 'Community Colleges' Scheme of UGC. During the academic years 2014-15 & 2015-16 ten collages affiliated to SPPU have received an amount of Rs. 7.9 Crore for introducing Diploma Courses under Community College Scheme.

9. Establishment of Department of Technology:

Savitribai Phule Pune University with an aim to provide research platform for solving cutting edge industry relevant research problem has established a dedicated 'Department of Technology'. The Department has prime objectives of gaining more vitality and acceptance in industrial and academic sectors, inculcate and promote research culture to think out-of-the-box so as to provide research solutions pertinent to the industry problems and help strengthen the 'Make in India' campaign. The Department runs industry-University sponsored M.Tech-Ph.D courses in variety of science and engineering disciplines. The sponsoring industries partners help define quality research problems of immediate relevance.

10. Gold Medals and Chairs:

University has around 782 donors and their Corpus as on 30/03/2016 is Rs. 37.67crores. University has instituted 111 Gold Medals to be awarded to the students of the various

faculties. 185 students from University departments have received Gold medals during last five years. University has 19 Chairs which have corpus of Rs. 19.30 Crore. The Mahatma Gandhi and the DRDO-ISRO Chairs are funded by Government of Maharashtra and Government of India respectively.

11. Employee Welfare Schemes

The University has introduced a large number of welfare schemes for teaching and academic faculty, and non teaching staff. The policy regarding welfare is instituted by the University and accordingly various welfare schemes area administered.

As per MHRD's National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) our University is Ranked at 10th Position. Ours is the only University in Maharashtra to achieve this status and is one of the Top five state Universities in the country. The University is the most preferred destination for international students coming to India.

NAAC Accreditation – The Savitribai Phule Pune University is re-accredited with A+ Grade in March 2017 with a CGPA of 3.60 by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) an autonomous institution of the University Grants Commission. This the highest CGPA achieved by any University in the state of Maharashtra.

University with Potential for Excellence (UPE) – Our University has been recognized by University Grants Commission as University with potential for Excellence. Through the funding received under this scheme the university has introduced modern ICT based methods of teaching and learning, evaluation methods for achieving excellence in teaching and research.

Performing University – The University has been recognized as the Performing University in "A" Category for Value added research and development by Department of Science and Technology (DST) of Government of India continuously for two phases under its "Promotion of University Research and Scientific Excellence (PURSE) Programme "

Development of Research Publication Portal – The Research Publication Portal is developed to showcase the research done by the faculty at international level during last year there has been a tremendous growth in publication of research articles at International Level. The number of research publications has gone up to 4774 in the year 2016-17 from 1569 in the year 2011-12. This has increase the H-index of the University from 40 in 2011-12 to 103

Centre for Intelligent System (CIS) – The department of Technology's Centre for Intelligent System (CIS) under the initiative of Rashtriya Uchhatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) has been digitally launched by the Minister of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Hon'ble Shri. Prakash Javadekar, at the University in April 2017.

Development of MOOC's Course – The Skill Development Centre of our University has developed a MOOC's Course on "Fundamentals in Retail Management" which is now hosted on "SWAYAM" Platform a website developed by the ministry of Human Resource

Development, Government of India in Association with EMMRC Pune. The Savitribai Phule Pune University is the only University in Maharashtra to have such a course.

Design Innovation Centre - The Design Innovation Centre of the University has developed a stick for visually impaired students with Ultrasonic Sensor and Micro Controller. It enables the visually impaired students to know any kind of hurdles from the distance of Six feet.

Extension of Name – Formerly known as University of Pune, the University was renamed as Savitribai Phule Pune University. This was to acknowledge the social contribution of great Indian reformer and poet Savitribai Phule. She is widely revered for her revolutionary work of social reform and education.

The University actively participants in Global Initiatives of Academic Networks (GIAN), UGC initiative, with aimed at tapping the talent pool of scientists and entrepreneurs internationally to encourage their engagement with the institutes of Higher Education in India so as to augment the country's existing academic resources, accelerate the pace of quality Reform and elevate India's scientific and technological capacity to global excellence.

Curricular Aspects – The Curricula of UG and PG courses are revised regularly. Under the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). There are three mandatory prime components

namely core components, inter-disciplinary components and Vocational Components/Skill components. The teachers of the university frequently used innovative teaching methods for curriculum delivery to support the traditional teaching methods.

E-Learning – University has a fully functional state-of-the-art e-content creation studio which facilitates teachers to record their sessions using various IT tools in High Definition Video format. Modern technologies are extensively used by University Faculties for Lecture preparation.

Sessions can be broadcasted live over internet to students of affiliated colleges with mechanism to receive queries through website.

The University has developed several 'Digital Classrooms' for effective and efficient delivery of lectures.

Enrichment Courses – University has initiated a special guidance programmes in soft skills for students from Tribal area and also for other students. Through this support, a tremendous change has been noticed in the students from rural as well as urban colleges with respect to the communication skills and personality development.

The colleges are given a flexibility to organize large number of special guidance camps on soft skill programmes. The University has included following mandatory credit courses over and above the prescribed curricula:

The University has made a provision to provide fellowship to all the students registered for M.Phil. and Ph.D. working in University departments, Affiliated colleges and recognized institutes.

The University provides seed research funding from its own funds to the teachers on campus and in affiliated colleges/recognized institutes to explore research ideas leading to larger proposals for generating funding from various agencies. To maintain high quality research output, the University organizes 'Research Project Competition' at different places under the university jurisdiction. A large number of students participate in these competitions. The selected projects/papers are presented in the 'Avishkar'- A State Level Research Competition' held annually in different Universities.

Fellowships – POSCO Asia Fellowships are provided to promising student of Savitribai Phule Pune University pursuing their Master Course in the field of Humanities and Social Sciences.

The D. K. Bhawe Scholarship are provided to students pursuing Master's Degree courses in Engineering Faculty at Accredited Universities in America, Canada, United Kingdom/Germany.

Central Instrumentation Facility (CIF) – At the global level the research in basic sciences has crossed the boundaries and emerging as an interdisciplinary concept merging Chemical, Life, Physical and Earth sciences area under one roof. This scientific research demands needs for state-of-art sophisticated instrumentation support in order to work in high priority research area.

To cater the need of researchers in different areas, the Central Instrument Facility (CIF) has been established at the University. The centre houses sophisticated analytical instructions mentioned below which are operated and maintained by a dedicated and qualified group of Scientists and Engineers. This facility is extended to all the researchers from universities, academic institutes, national research institutes, defense institutes and industries in Maharashtra.

Jayakar Library – Jayakar Library is the central library facility of the university. It is one of the best centres of reference and information in the country. The Library is named as Jayakar Library to pay tribute to Barrister M.R. Jayakar, the Founder Vice-Chancellor of the University.

- Various reference sources including encyclopaedia, dictionaries, yearbooks, biographies, gazetteers, etc.
- 4000+ e-books on perpetual basis

- Subscription to eminent international databases
- More than 8000 online journals
- Over 3000 manuscripts of quality literary works written in Hindi, Sanskrit and Marathi
- Music Library of rare and old musical collection

International Center (IC) – The University has emerged as a favoured destination for International Students from across the globe. The University provides high quality education at affordable costs. The University can boast of having the largest number of International Students in comparison to all other Indian Universities.

The International Centre acts as a Co-ordination agency between the students, the various Departmental Heads, and the Heads of Colleges and Institutions, affiliated to the University as well as the Heads of Chancery, Embassies, Consulates, their educational counsellors and their educational wings.

Students Facilitation Centre – The jurisdiction of university is spread over three districts namely Pune, Nashik and Ahmednagar more than 7 lakh students Are pursuing their studies in the colleges and recognized institutions. These students have to frequently interact with the university during and after completion of their education for variety of purposes including requirement of various documents.

'Students Facilitation Centre' is a facility created on main campus at Pune and two district sub-centres of the university that allows students to submit standardized information and documents with a single entry point to fulfil all documents-related requirements.

The archived electronic information further facilitates the process by avoiding multiple data submissions.

- Students Facilitation Centre (SFC) facilitates hassels free transanctions with the university under one roof with the help of technology and streamlined processes.
- Through SFC, students can make payments and obtain various documents from the university.
- University has such two satellite facilitation centres at our Ahmednagar and Nashik sub-centre.

The main value proposition for having a single window facility for the university is to increase the efficiency through time and cost savings for all the stakeholders in their interactions with the university authorities for obtaining the relevant documents and permissions for a variety of purposes. In a traditional set up, the stakeholders may have had to contend with visits and interactions with multiple university offices in multiple locations to obtain the necessary papers and permissions to complete their processes.

Equipped with state-of-the-art IT platforms and connectivity, the SFC delivers essential services to the students in a time bound manner with high efficiency. Important sections of the university are connected through well-developed policies and procedures to carry out this massive task with utmost accuracy and reliability.

Provision to make online applications and payments along with door-delivery of the documents ensures student-friendly delivery of essential services.

SFC intends to go beyond normal ambit of the facilities offered with a proactive approach by deploying intelligent systems capable of sensing future requirements of the users to prompt them of their document-related requirements and advise them of appropriate procedures along with prescribed timelines. SFC would also leverage the 'DigiLocker' initiative of the Government so that the students can access all their documents without having to go through the present procedures.

Outreach Activities – Science Park – Nurturing spirit of inquiry in the young and impressionable minds of school children is one of the most important and primary task society. Scientific attitude needs to be developed by sharing excitement of science and technology, by curiosity driven open ended experiments, by exposing them to wonderful world of Nature. All over the world, there are SCIENCE

PARKS or Science Museums, full of science exhibits, demonstration experiments, do it yourself laboratories, nature trails which let the young minds explore ideas, put them in action and bring the excitement of modern developments in science and technology. With this noble intention the science park project initiated as a novel project for school going children.

Governance & Best Practices – Well defined vision and leadership with ideas and set philosophy are the necessary prerequisites for the growth of institution like Savitribai Phule Pune University. The University has nurtured a vision consistent with its rich traditions and followed a new path of development. The principal focus of the University has been to facilitate learning and scholarship all the way up to the current frontiers of knowledge, research that pushes the frontiers of knowledge, technology at the cutting edge, innovations to address, problems and opportunities in industry/society and entrepreneurship that generates wealth in the society.

Automation and e-Governance – The University has a pervasive presence in three large districts of Maharashtra. As a part of our consistent endeavours to maintain high academic quality and improve governance the University has adopted various ICT based process automations.

Process automation focused on :

- Enhanced Efficiency & Effectiveness of Processes
- Better Accountability & Responsiveness of Services
- Ensuring Inclusiveness & Equity by ease of Access Bringing in more Transparency & Participation in the system.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) – The IQAC has developed a system for conscious, consistent and catalytic improvement in the performance of the university and has played significant role in getting the University re-accredited (Third Cycle) by NAAC. The University has been accredited with "A⁺" grade with CGPA – 3.60.

The IQAC has developed a well defined procedure for collection of feedback from Stakeholders. Based on the analysis of feedback and suggestions of stakeholders necessary improvements in teaching learning methods and infrastructural facilities were made. The IQAC has also develop a mechanism for Academic and Administrative Audit of the Academic and Administrative departments.

Best Practices and Innovations - The University has explored innovative and creative ways to design and implement strategies for achieving excellence in teaching and research. This has delivered significant results in the classrooms and research laboratories, in global outreach and community connect, in fulfilling aspirations of all the stakeholders and in contributing to the national development.

Skill Development Centre – Skill Development Centre at Savitribai Phule Pune University was established in March 2014 with an objective to eliminate disconnect between academics and the reality in the global job market. The Centre has introduced three year B.Voc. Degree programmes, which are well focused on training undergraduate and post graduate students of University in various employable skills so as to enhance their employability. Rigorous training is given to students in communication skills, sound values and professional ethics to enable them to venture out with confidence and prove their caliber in the competitive workplace.

Nine colleges affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University have also been identified by UGC to introduce B.Voc. Programmes Apart from these, 10 colleges have received grants under 'Community Colleges' Scheme of UGC.

Design Innovation Centre - The Design Innovation Centre (DIC) aims to establish a network with the, industries, end users, farmers etc. So as to understand their problems and provide solutions. It serves as a link between Savitribai Phule Pune University Faculty, Spoke Centres and Industry Partners. The DIC serves as consortium of research faculty, students on the campus and at the spoke centres. Thus, with the active participation of University faculty and Spoke centres, various innovative ideas are being envisioned and executed leading to the development of number of prototypes for the end-users and similarly generate funds for the sustenance and continuation of DIC activities.

DIC activity targeted to rural population is implemented through Vigyan Ashram (VA) located at Pabal. Vigyan Ashram is a center of Indian Institute of Education (IIE) and is the first digital fabrication Lab established in association with MIT, USA. The digital fabrication lab is involved in the making of Laser cutting, Vinyl cutting machines, PCB making engraving machines, 3-D printers etc. Two more spoke centres at Ahmednagar and Nashik are being developed.

4. FINANCE AND DEVELOPMENT

- 1 Gold Medals and Chairs :** University has around 812 donors and their Corpus as on 31.03.2017 is Rs. 52.18 crores. University has instituted 137 Gold Medals to be awarded to the students of the various faculties. University has 22 Chairs/Adhyasans. Of these, 20 Chairs have corpus. The Mahatma Gandhi and the DRDO-ISRO Chairs are funded by Government of Maharashtra and Government of India respectively.
- 2 Mediclaim Policy:** The Group Mediclaim and Group Accident policy scheme is being implemented for University Teaching and Non-Teaching employees (Government Approved, University Fund and Self-Supporting Departments, Statutory posts, Teaching & Non Teaching Staff on contractual basis and on regular pay scale) The Mediclaim policy of the year 2016-17 is of Floater type. 1470 university employees and 2824 relatives of the university employees are covered under this scheme. The sum insured under this scheme is Rs. 3 lakh for employees and family members. University teaching and non-teaching employees serving on Government sanctioned posts, University funded posts and confirmed employees who are serving for the period of more than 20 years in self-supporting Departments, Statutory posts and Teaching & Non Teaching Staff on contractual basis and on regular pay scale are eligible for this scheme. University has shouldered 100% financial responsibility of the premium for the employees and in case of relative's 50% premium of the insurance policy shall be paid by the University and 50% premium shall be deducted from the employees' salary.
- 3 Investments:** The aggregate 'Investments' of the University was Rs. 519 Cores 27 lakh as on 31.03.2017.
- 4 University Publication:** The services rendered by the publication section of the University were strengthened to suit the needs of the students. As a result, the Publication Section succeeded in collecting Rs. 3,05,312/- during 2015-16, through the sale of various publications.
- 5 Donations :** The University has received donations to the extent of Rs 15.37 lakh during the financial year 2016-17.
- 6 Grants from Funding Agencies :** The University is striving to be self-sufficient in the near future. University has received funds of Rs. 41.79 Crores from various funding agencies for research and other academic purpose during the period between 01.07.2016 to 30.06.2017.

2) Specialists Services at Students Health Service Scheme office:-

The Students needing Specialists consultation are referred to specialists Centre at University campus.

Students, employees, and foreign students availed the benefit of the Specialists services.

3) Financial help to the students:-

During the year under consideration 21 students were give financial help up to Rs. 1, 54,958/- for operation & other treatment.

4) Medical Examination of University hostel Students and International Students:-

Medical Examination of 484 University Post-Graduate hostel students, 400 International Students were undertaken at Student's Health Services.

5) SPECIAL FEATURES:-

i) Yoga Education Centre:-

Yoga Education Centre was started w.e.f. March 2002 in collaboration with Shriram Madhava Yoga Samiti Kaivalyadham, Lonavla U.G.C. has sanctioned a grant for the Yoga education centre.

Separate classes are held for males & females. Four classes (two in the morning & two in the evening) are held working days. Two female yoga instructor were involved in teaching yogasanas to students and employees.

ii) Yoga Certificate Course:-

Part time Certificate Course in yoga of 3 months duration was started from August 2003 in collaboration with Shriman Madhava Yoga Samiti Kaivalyadhama, Lonavla.

During the period of report around 485 persons took advantage of the facility.

JAYAKAR KNOWLEDGE RESOURCE CENTRE

Introduction:

The Jayakar Library is recently named as Jayakar Knowledge Resource Centre (as Per The Universities Act 2016). It is the central library of the Savitribai Phule Pune University. The library is 67 years old and functioning from an independent building of its own running in about 1, 50,000 sq.ft. Area. The activities recounted in this report demonstrate the commitment of Library staff to contributing to the fulfillment of Savitribai Phule Pune

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University's academic mission. The 2016–2017 Annual Report provides just a glimpse into the work of our dedicated Library staff carried out throughout the year.

Knowledge Resource Committee:

The Knowledge Resource Committee (consisting 7 members) is the apex body. It is the apex body of the Library System that frames the policies and procedures for the smooth functioning of the Library. The Knowledge Resource Committee met once during the year of the report. The Chairman and the members of the Knowledge Resource Committee made several suggestions in providing better services to the users of the Jayakar Library.

Budget Provisions:

The total budget for the year April 2016-March 2017 of the Jayakar Knowledge Centre was Rs.5,92,000/ out of which an amount of Rs. 3 Crores was provided for the subscription of periodicals and online databases, and Rs. 1.50 Crore for purchase of books and e-books. The funds provided to the Knowledge Resource Centre have been fully utilized. The insurance of the collection, equipment and Library Building has been continued.

Acquisitions of Reading Material:

The library has made available sufficient funds to all teaching departments which were approved by the Knowledge Resource Centre Committee. Many scholarly print and electronic books were acquired during the period of report as per the recommendations of the heads of the departments and teachers.

The reading hall was kept open on all the days of the week (including Sundays and holidays) between 7.00a.m. - 12.00p.m.

Reference Service:

Reference Service is the remarkable feature of any library. During the year of the report Knowledge Resource Centre has provided references in person, on telephone and through email. During the year of the report the number of such users is about 782. The Jayakar Knowledge Resource Centre also extends the facility of referring the library to those who are not the regular members of the library. Various participants of the variety of courses conducted their study tours and visited the library. For the new entrants of the university i.e. MA or MSc students, orientation programmes were conducted. In addition to this the assistance was provided to use OPAC, to use card catalogue and locating the reading material.

Reading and Research Facilities:

Jayakar Knowledge Resource Centre has a separate building for study purpose. Presently four reading halls having a capacity of 150 readers each are used by students. Reading and research facilities including bibliographical aids were extended to the Heads of the Departments, University Teachers, Post-graduate students, research scholars and research workers from sister universities and institutions. Specialized reading



atmosphere is provided to the research students on selective basis. Assistance has been provided in using the online journals, open source documents, document delivery service, documentation service and other library services. Under Document Delivery Service the Knowledge Resource Centre receives articles from other Universities. On the other hand the Knowledge Resource Centre has sent 37 articles on request to the users who required them.

Jayakar Knowledge Resource Centre Portal:

The main objective behind the development of Knowledge Resource Centre portal was to provide one window access to library resources as well as free resources to all in-house and outside users. To achieve this objective Knowledge Resource Centre has developed

E- Resources Portal that contains information regarding online union catalogues of books, theses and serial publications. Web links are provided to various National Libraries, Open Access Resources of variety of subjects and databases. The said portal is accessible through Internet and it is very useful to the students, staff, researchers and general public and libraries of the affiliated colleges of the University. The Library portal is accessible through web address <http://lib.unipune.ac.in/Portal/portal.html> All the subscribed resources can be accessed remotely through e-zproxy software.

Some of the prominent online databases which are subscribed by the Knowledge Resource Centre are as below:

1. **EBSCO's Academic Search Primere:** This is a leading scholarly multidisciplinary full text database. It covers more than 13,780 indexed and abstracted journals. More than 4,770 full text journals. Subjects include Biology, Chemistry, Engineering, Physics, Psychology, Religion, Philosophy, and Science & Technology.
2. **EBSCO's Communication and Mass Media Complete** -Providing the most robust, quality research solution in areas related to communication and mass media .It covers 500 full text journals. Many major journals have indexing, abstracts, PDFs and searchable cited references from their first issues to the present (dating as far back as 1915).
3. **EBSCO's Business Source Complete-** It is a leading collection of bibliographic and full text content of business journals. Indexing and abstracts for the most important scholarly business journals from 1886 are included in this resource. In addition, searchable cited references are provided for more than 1,300 journals.
4. **Psych Articles** - It is very useful resource for psychology researchers. All American Psychological Association's published journals plus Canadian Psychological Association and English language journals from Hogrefe Publishing group are covered. Complete coverage of all subject areas relevant to psychological science is included. It covers more than 100 full text journals.
5. **Manupatra** - It is an indigenous online database in the field of law. It covers resources about law, taxation, corporate and business policy.
6. **IEEE/IEE Electronic Library (IEL) Online-** provides Internet access to the full text of the non-monographic publications of U.S.' Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers and U.K.'s Institution of Electrical Engineers IEEE and Information Handling

Services (IHS) developed the online version of IEL .I EEE and IEE's publications cover a wide area of engineering including but not limited to electrical and computer engineering, software engineering, biomedical technology, telecommunications, electric power, and consumer electronics. The content in IEL Online is geared toward researchers with fairly sophisticated technical knowledge; however there are several publications suitable for non-technical researchers. Full text access to more than 2 million articles in engineering and technology is a feature of it.

- 7. Proquest Ulrichs Web:** This is the online directory of more than 3 lakh periodicals with the details of their specifications.
- 8. LISA Full text** - Library and Information Science Abstracts is an international abstracting and indexing tool designed for library professionals and other information specialists. LISA currently abstracts over 440 periodicals from more than 68 countries and in more than 20 different languages.
- 9. EPWRF India Time Series:** It's an online database on Indian Economy and Politics that comprises over 25,000 variables in 14 modules.

- 14. REAXYS :** It contains an extensive repository of experimentally validated data that chemists need including structures, reactions and physical properties. Reaxys has extensive coverage of quality, authoritative information in organic, inorganic and organo-metallic chemistry.
- 15. Sage Research Methods Online :** It contains content from more than 640 books, dictionaries, encyclopaedias, and handbooks, the entire Little Green Book, and Little Blue Book series, etc. All these sources exclusively deal with research methods.
- 16. Indian Citations Index :** Indian R&D literature across all disciplines i.e. science, technology, medicine, agriculture, social science and humanities get published in 1000 plus journals/ serials or in other documents emanating from India.
- 17. ACM Digital Library :** It contains 1384 Journals, 21,587 Proceedings, 146889 books,

74544 Theses.

- 18. FEDGATE :** Fedgate is a single point search facility for subscribed E resources by Jayakar Knowledge Resource Centre.

19. Proquest Literature Online:

It is a fully integrated service that combines the texts of over 355,000 literary works in English with a vast library of key criticism and reference resources.

- 20. PNAS :** (Proceedings of National Academy of Sciences) contains biological, physical, and social sciences journals. Back files are available from 1915 till date.

21. Indian Journals (Library Science Package):

It contains the vast collection of interdisciplinary Indian journals and research publications.

- 22. AIR DVD :** All India Reporter Online Database is containing Case Laws of AIR Journal from 1950 to 2014, Criminal Law Journal from 1950 – 2014 and Supreme Court Weekly Journal from 1991 to 2014. All major bare acts with citations are provided along with.

- 23. CLA Online :** (Corporate Law Advisor Database) is India's premier online exclusive e-library on Corporate / SEBI and Business Laws since 1950 from the house of "Corporate Law Adviser" a more than two decade old leading publishing house on the subject. The e-library consists of Case Laws (with head notes), Wealth of intellectual knowledge in the shape of Articles by experts, Procedures under Company Law, Resolutions, Queries and their Replies by experts, Notifications and Circulars of various Ministries / Departments, Updated legislations etc.

- 24. SCOPUS :** SCOPUS is a bibliographic database containing abstracts and citations for academic journal articles. It covers nearly 22,000 titles from over 5,000 publishers, of which 20,000 are peer-reviewed journals in the scientific, technical, and medical and social sciences including arts and humanities. Searches are linked to patent databases. An additional feature of SCOPUS is the authors' profiles.

- 25. Journal Citation Report :** This database offers citation data that offers a mean to evaluate leading journals of the world. It shows the relationship between citing and cited journals available in the fields of Science, Social Science and Technology.

- 26. I - Scholar (Common Ground International Collection) –** It's a collection of peer-reviewed scholarly journals. Presently the Jayakar Knowledge Resource Centre is subscribing 25 journals from Common Ground International Collection.

This database covers a wide range of topics in the domain of Arts, New Media Technology, Politics and Community Studies, Communication and Linguistic Studies, Literature, Humanities, Management and Education and others.

Smt. Vijaya Deshmukh Internet Centre

The Knowledge Resource Centre has extended the facility to access e-journals to its users. The postgraduate and research students are enjoying the benefit of the said facility through Smt. Vijaya Deshmukh Internet Centre, which is having 35 computer

terminals with Internet facility. Additionally the facility of accessing online resources has been extended in the Reference Hall of the Library.

Digital Library: -

Jayakar Knowledge Resource Centre has developed its own Digital Library of rare material. Knowledge Resource Centre has a variety of collection of rare documents in the form of books, manuscripts, maps, photographs, letters of eminent persons etc. The aim of the project is to digitize documents of common interest and make them available through Intranet and Internet.

Shodhganga – The Shodhganga project of UGC INFLIBNET is of the digitized theses.

After entering into MoU on 26th April 2011, till date more than 7200 theses of our university have been digitized and uploaded on this site. The Knowledge Resource Centre is also uploading the latest degree awarded theses of the university.

UGC Study Centre:

The UGC Study Centre is under the control of the Jayakar Knowledge Resource Centre. The centre provides reading facilities to undergraduate students from affiliated colleges and recognized institutions. The reading hall was kept open from 8.00 a.m. to 11.45 p.m. throughout the year.

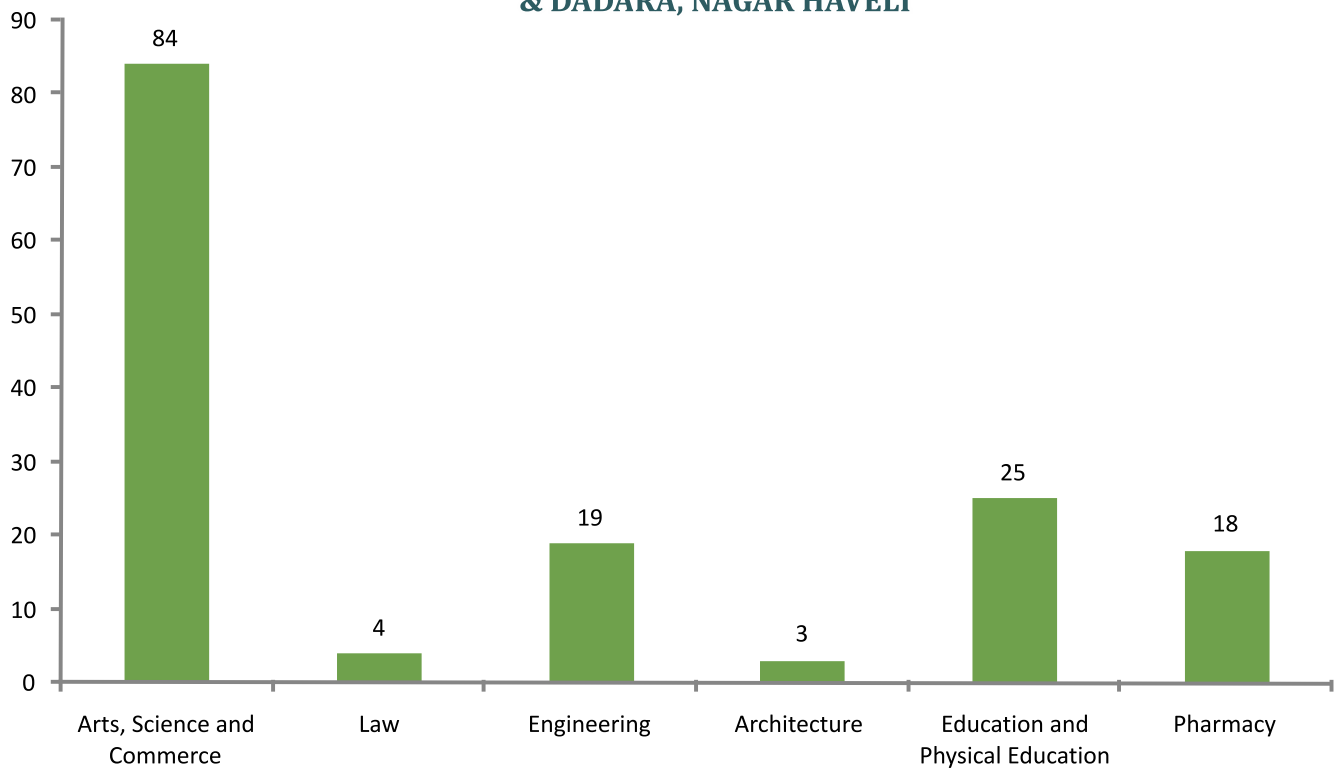
NUMBER OF FACULTYWISE COLLEGES IN PUNE

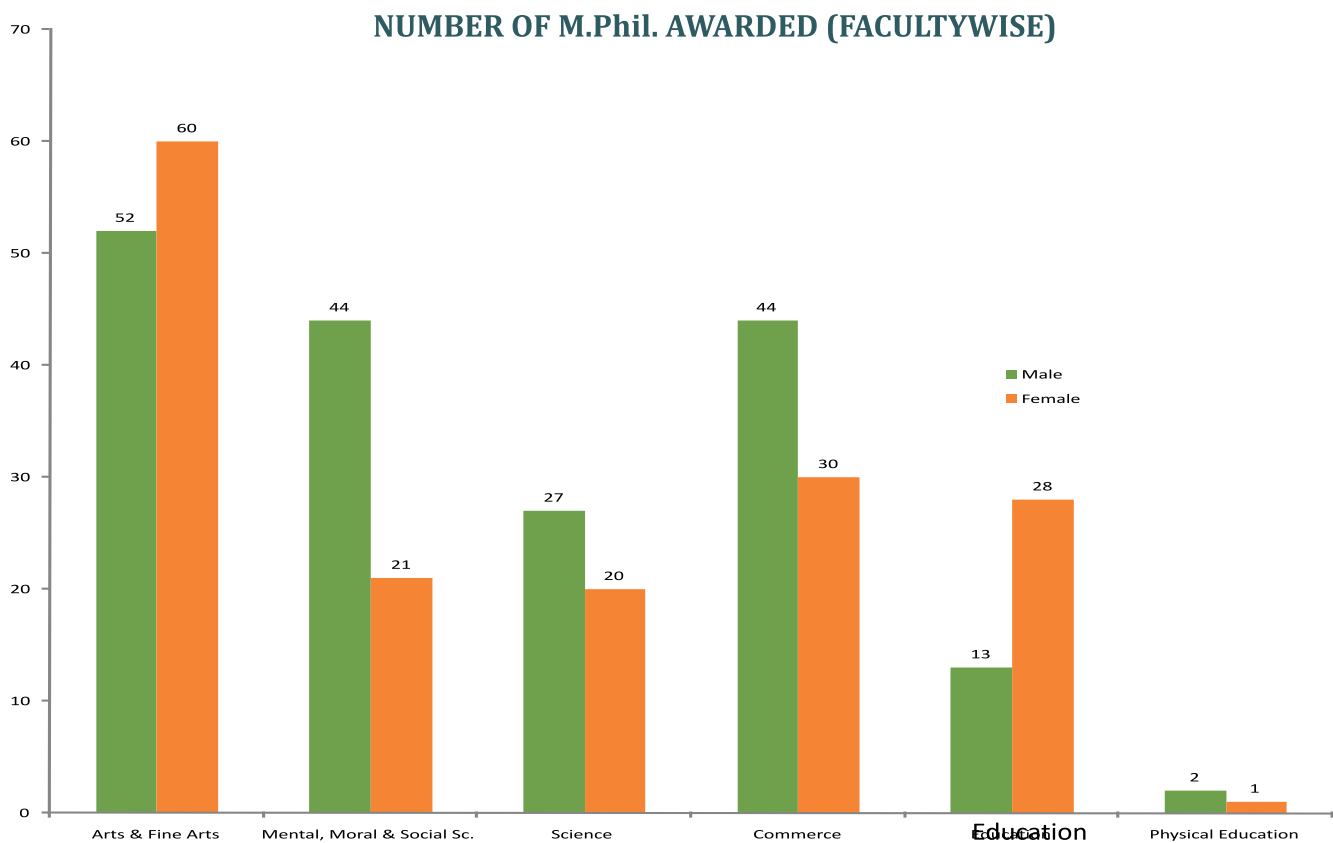
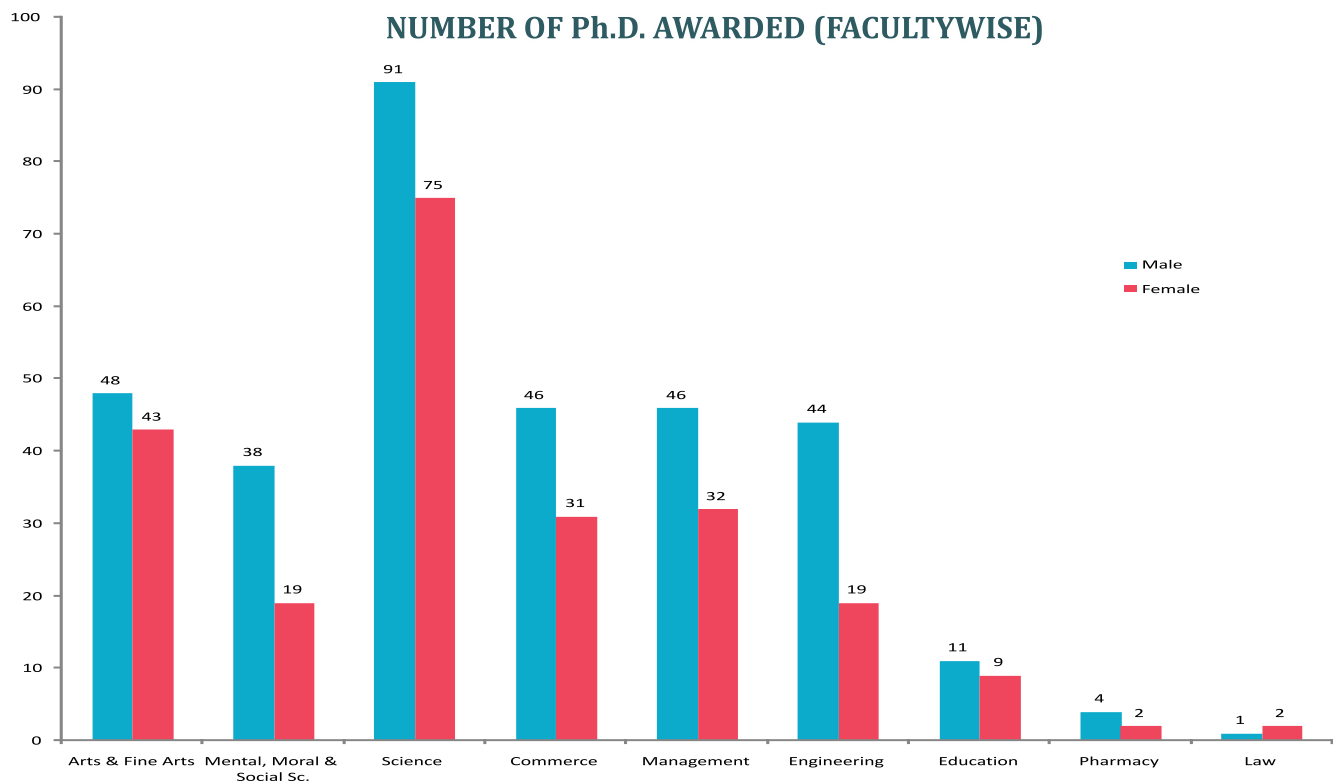


NUMBER OF FACULTYWISE COLLEGES IN AHMEDNAGAR

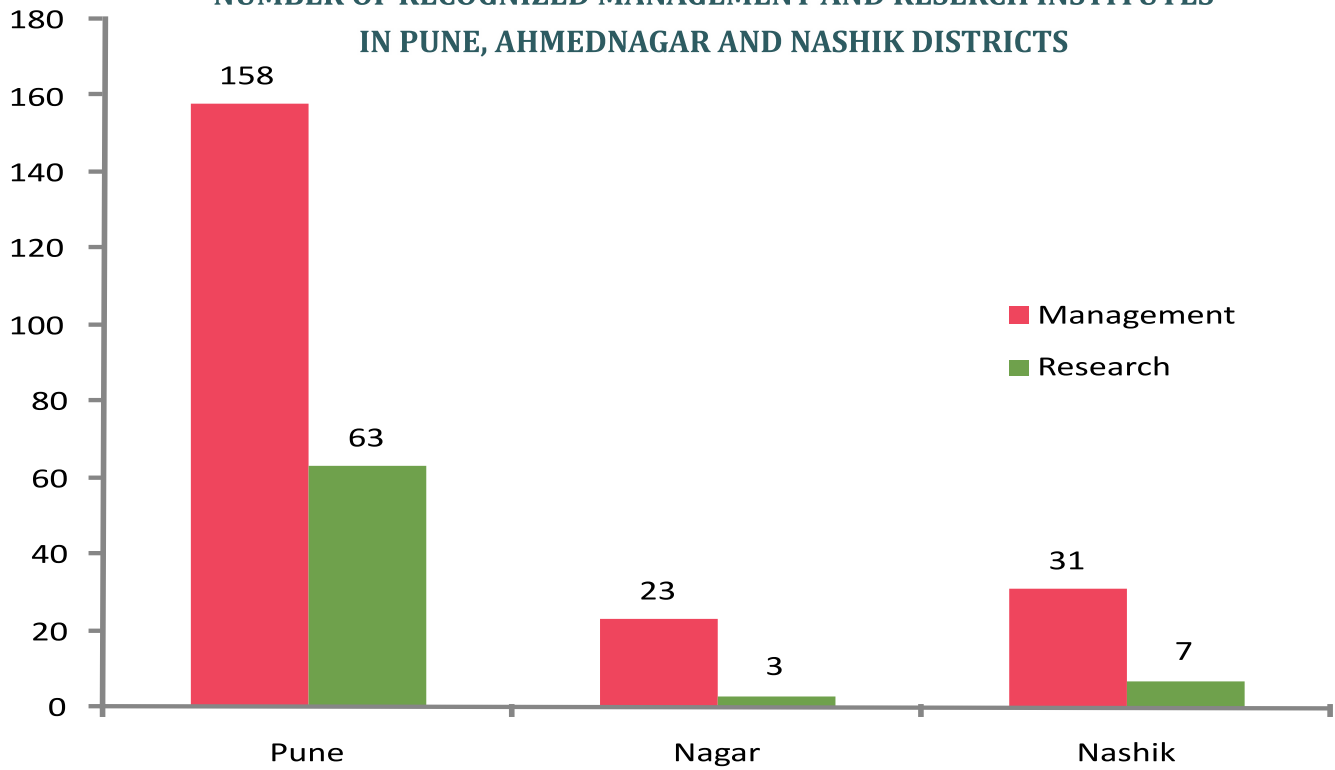


NUMBER OF FACULTYWISE COLLEGES IN NASHIK
& DADARA, NAGAR HAVELI

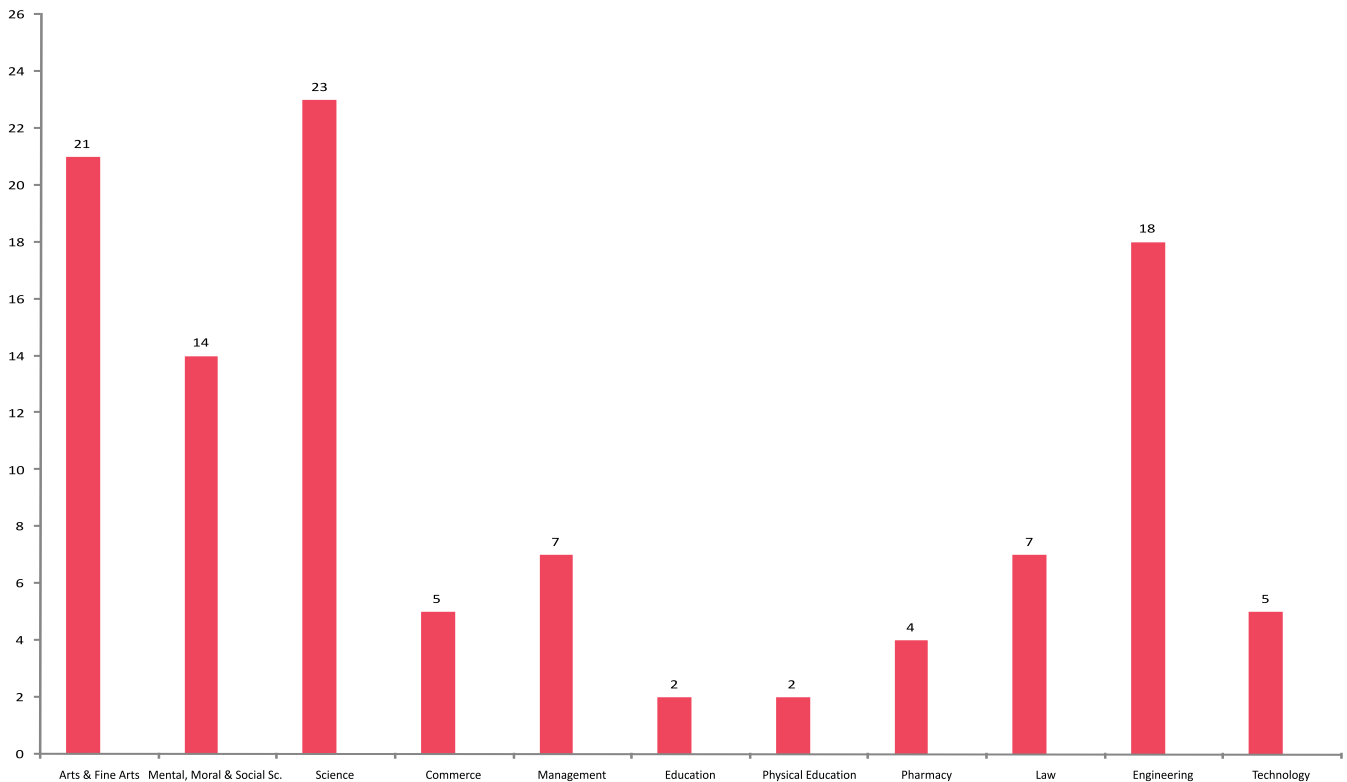




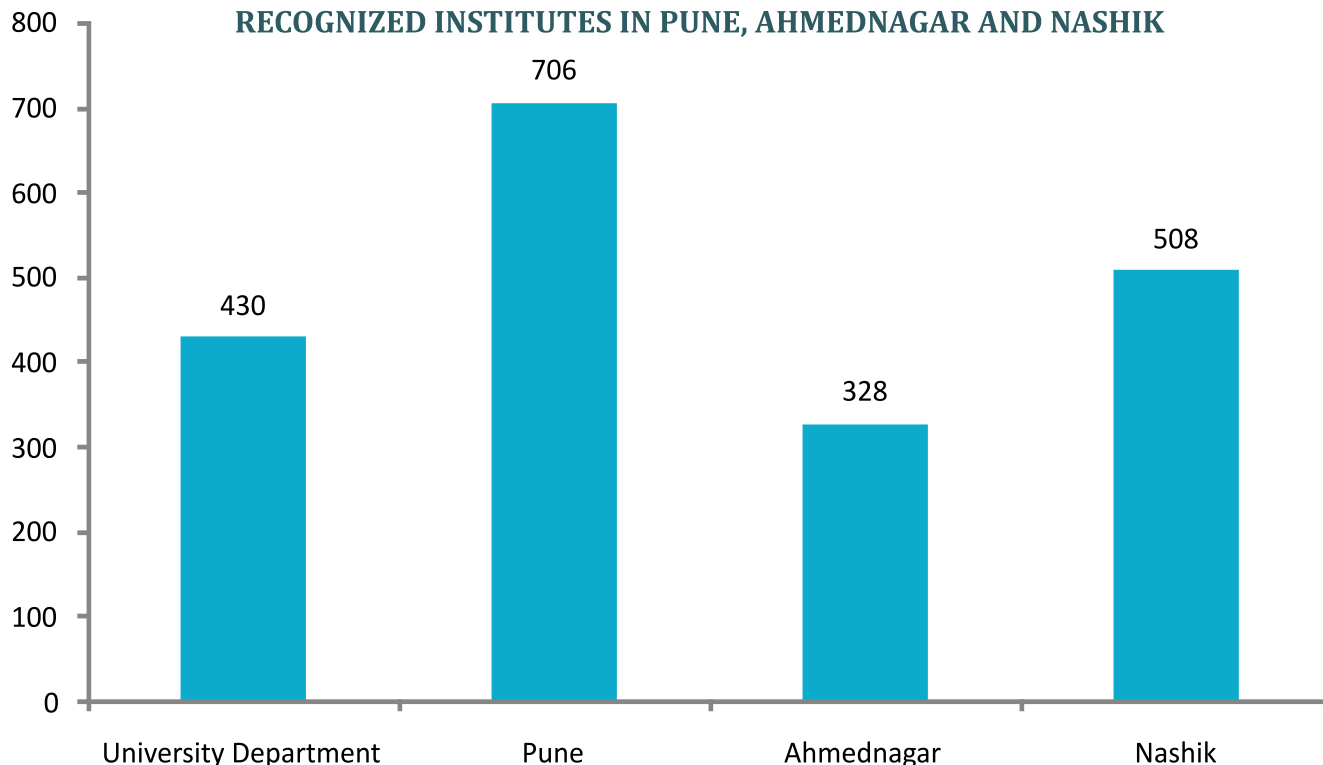
**NUMBER OF RECOGNIZED MANAGEMENT AND RESEARCH INSTITUTES
IN PUNE, AHMEDNAGAR AND NASHIK DISTRICTS**



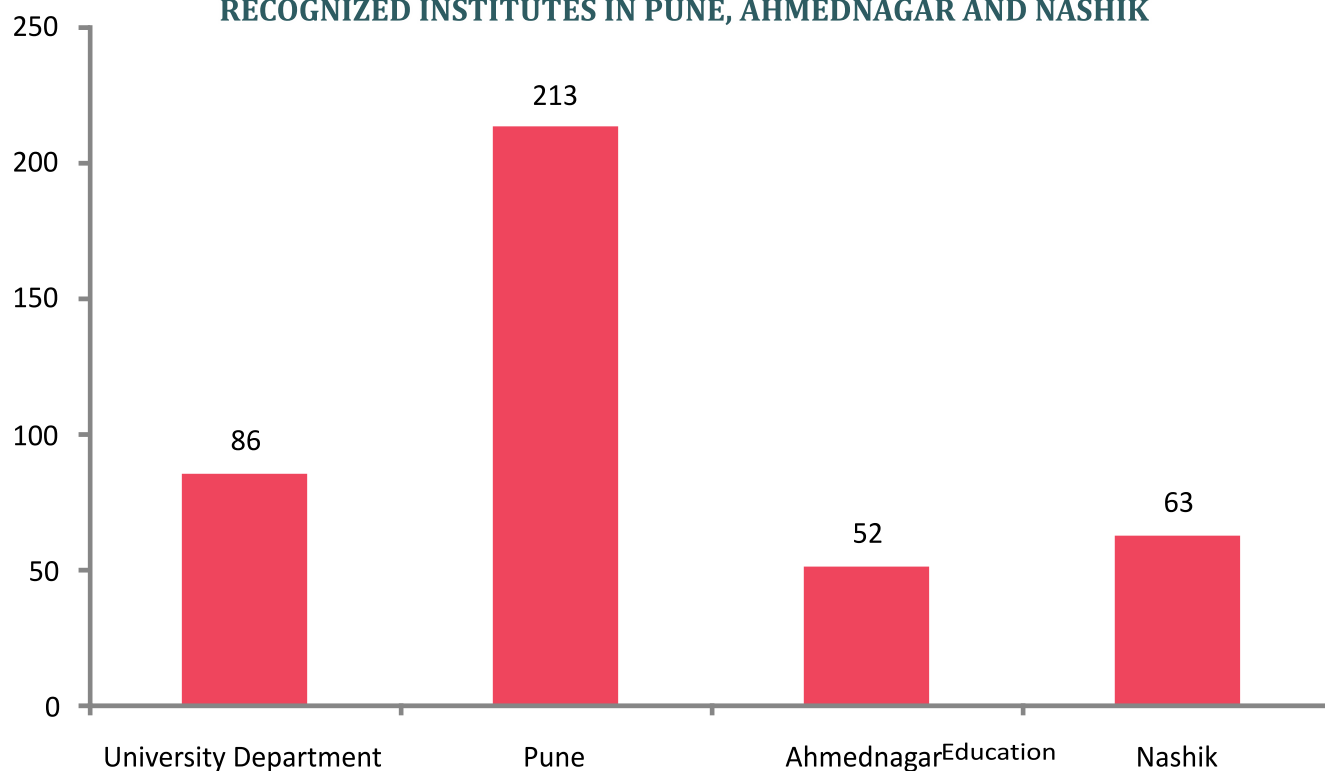
